WAGD Ring Rental Agreement



We are so glad to be able to offer our space and equipment to our amazing agility teams to help keep their skills sharp between classes! In order to make sure everyone has the same great experience when they rent the ring,

we have the following rules we ask everyone to follow:

- <u>All dogs must have completed our Great Agility Program.</u> Before dogs can be on equipment without the support of a trainer, they must have completed our Great Agility program or have been given specific permission by their instructor.
- Equipment in the ring cannot be moved or altered. This applies to tunnels, contacts, and even the little cones! Courses are designed with the safety and path of the dog in mind. Jump bars can be moved to appropriate heights for your dog.
- One dog is allowed in the ring at a time. One person may bring more than one dog, but only one dog can be in the ring at a time. Additional dogs should be crated inside or outside of the ring. You can split ring rentals with friends, but please only have one dog in the ring at a time. Max of 3 dogs per 30 min ring rental.
- Do not allow your dog to wander. If you are not actively training or running your dog, please do not allow them to wander. This is when most accidents happen.
- <u>Clean up after your dog.</u> It takes a split second for a dog to mark an obstacle. Potty accidents in the ring have long term effects and can distract dogs up to weeks after. If your dog urinates or poops, please reach out to a WAGD staff member for assistance on cleaning. We need to keep track of these things to make a good training space for the people coming in after you. Repeat offenders will NOT be allowed to rent again.
- <u>Remove leashes when running your dogs.</u> Safety first! Dragging leashes over and through obstacles can be potential hazards to your dogs. Please remove leashes!
- **Provide your own treats and toys.** You are only permitted to use treats and toys that belong to you. If you didn't bring it, do not use it.
